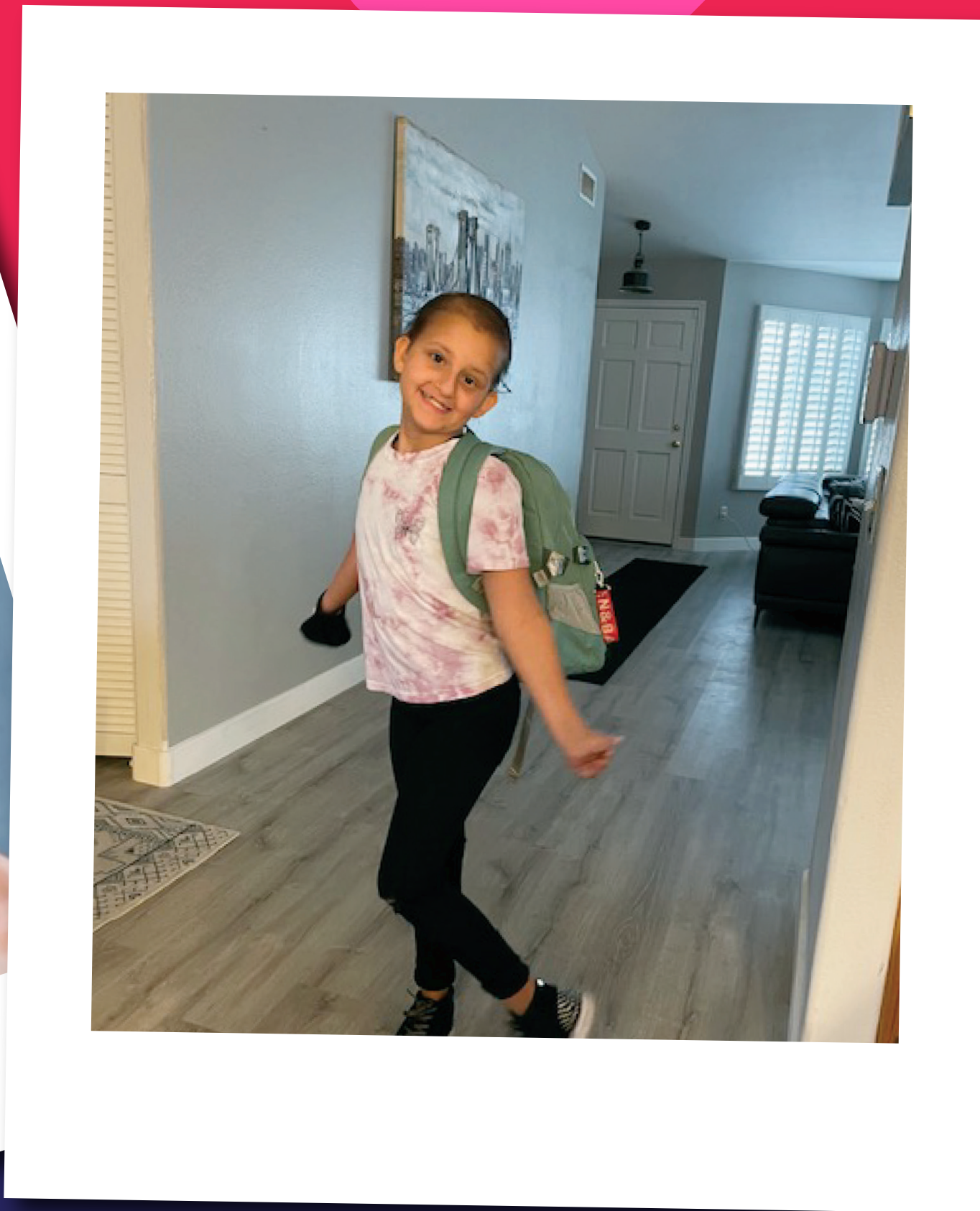


ADRI

She enjoys raising funds to benefit other kids like her at Phoenix Children's Hospital.

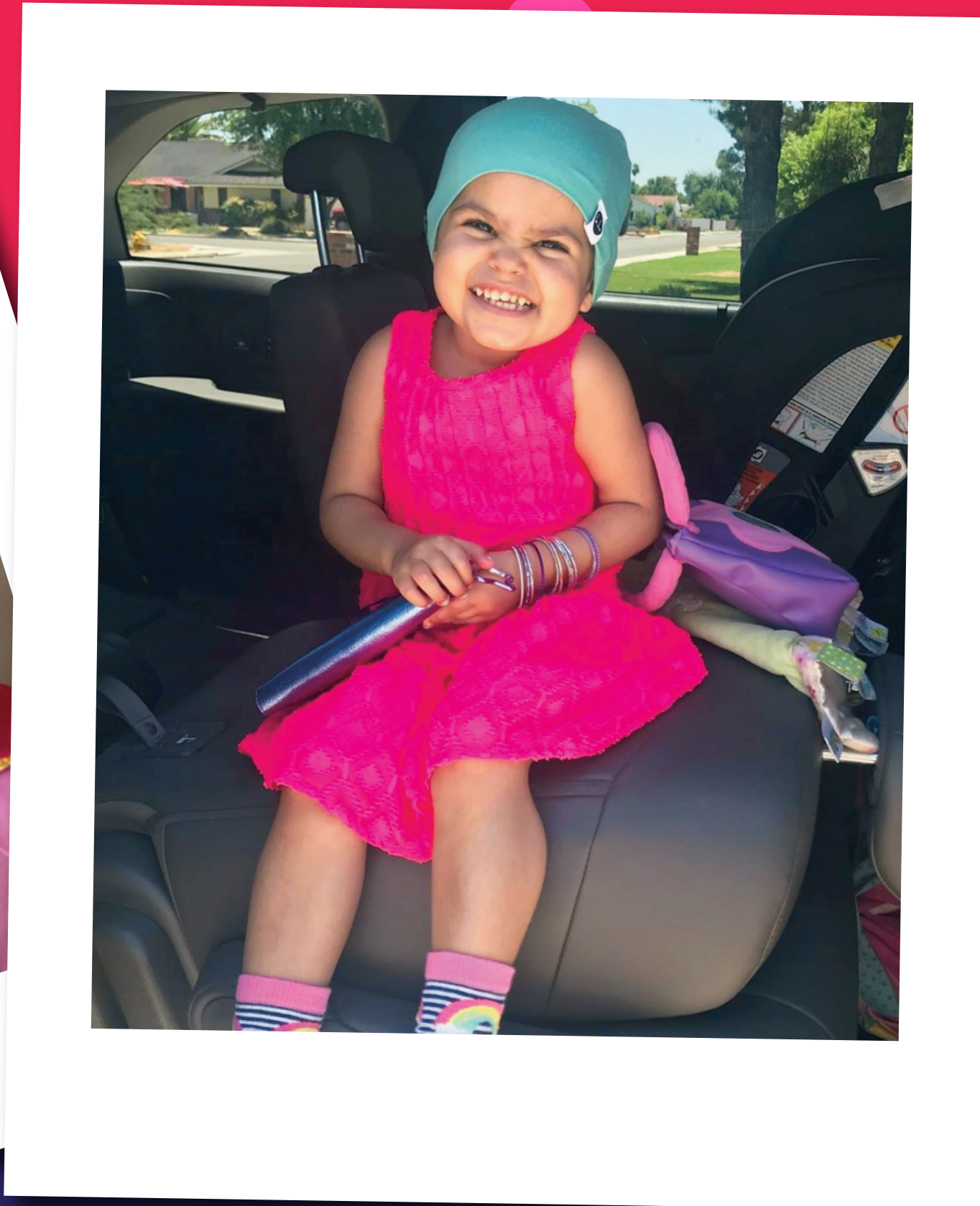
